From the Principal:

"Student and Parent Survey 2018"

Our school community is always looking at ways in which we can make improvements in what we do. In 2018 we conducted a survey with children from Grades 3-6 and all parents. We received 201 responses from the children and 171 parent responses.

Included below are some of the key findings from the children of SHS (Grades 3-6)

- •83% believe that SHS encourages them to be more like Jesus everyday
- 84% believe that SHS provides opportunities to pray
- 85% believe they are learning more about our Catholic faith
- 84% feel safe in their classroom
- 74% feel safe in the playground
- 84% agree that their teacher listens to them
- 90% agree that their teacher helps them
- •54% use the canteen
- •16% believe that we should only offer healthy food in the canteen
- •78% believe their teacher provides them with useful feedback about their learning
- •94% believe their teacher encourages them to work to the best of their ability
- •96% understand what behaviour is expected of them at school
- 92% understand the consequences of inappropriate behaviour
- •81% believe they are provided with opportunities to share their ideas
- •81% know what they are supposed to be learning
- 90% enjoy using iPads/Chromebooks
- •97% know the rules about using iPads/Chromebooks
- 79% believe SHS provides opportunities to discover strengths
- •85% believe SHS provides a supportive environment to achieve goals
- P.T.O •80% believe they have the opportunity to be a leader

Included below are some of the key findings from the <u>parents of SHS</u> (the percentages were derived by combining agree and strongly agree responses)

- •97% believe we provide opportunities for spiritual/faith development
- •75% believe our Staff model Christian values
- •92% believe Christian values are visible in our school
- •83% believe teachers treat students fairly
- •99% believe the school is well maintained
- 94% suggested that their child feels safe
- •83% believe student behaviour is well managed
- •88% feel welcome
- •53% believe the canteen should only offer healthy food
- •92% can talk to teachers about concerns
- •93% believe the report gives a good understanding about their child's progress and achievement
- •89% are satisfied with the forms of communication at SHS
- •85% believe SHS works with them to support their child's learning
- •79% believe SHS is looking at ways to improve what it does
- •90% are satisfied with SHS planning
- •97% believe teachers expect their child to do their best
- •85% believe teachers provide their child with useful feedback about their school work
- •91% believe their child's learning needs are being met
- •72% believe that iPads/Chromebooks enhances their child's learning
- •86% know the rules about using iPads/Chromebooks
- •92% believe that teachers motivate their child to learn
- •93% believe their child is making good progress at SHS
- •87% have confidence in how well SHS is managed
- •86% believe their is effective educational leadership at SHS

The responses received will be used along with information from staff, the TCEO and other data collected to inform our future decision making. Sincere thanks to our parents and children who responded to the survey, we appreciate the time and consideration given to the survey.

Student absences

If your child will be absent from school please remember to either:

- •call the School office on 63311011
- •email shsl@catholic.tas.edu.au
- •use the Skoolbag app, fill out an eForm
- ·advise their teacher

If you arrive at school after 9am your child must be walked into the office via the York Street gate and report to the school office to update our records and avoid unnecessary absentee text messages.

It is a legal requirement that parents are expected to advise the school as to why their child is absent.

Signing students out during the day

-You must sign your child out if you need to pick them up from school for an appointment or for your child to leave

early.

-Please pre-arrange this with your child's class teacher and the teacher will send your child to the office at the required time so you can collect them from the office and sign them out.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form <u>www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children</u>

- 2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
- Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the

school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.

Reminder - Before School expectations

Even though it is a parent responsibility to make arrangements for the supervision of your children before 8:30 a.m., S.H.S. offer an arrangement for families who need their children to be arriving at school earlier.

- Mrs. Deb Scott will be at school from 8:00am each school day for any students.
- Students are not to arrive before 8am
- If a student is here before 8:30 a.m. they need to go to the Gym. The cost will be \$2 per child per day, which needs to be paid as the student arrives at the Presentation Gym.
- The child's name will also be recorded on an attendance sheet on a daily basis.

Reminder that dogs are not permitted on the school grounds without prior permission from the Principal
