What Legacy Will We Leave?

"It takes a whole village to raise a child..." (African Proverb)

Last term we conducted interviews for our Kindergarten 2021 children. When families come to our school community we discuss a broad range of matters. First and foremost our discussion centres on enrolment at a Catholic school. This means that when we enrol our children, or in the case of staff take up employment, we agree to support the mission and vision of the Catholic Church.

Enrolment means supporting all aspects of our school, not just the ones we want to. Ultimately this will mean that at times we will be challenged by some aspects or some people in our school, as a member of any community that is to be expected. Just as in families we don't always get along with one another, so in schools there are times when things don't "work out" as we would want.

In Catholic Schools we are taught that we are all created in the image of God and indeed we are all created equally. This means we can't pick and choose who we are nice to, we are challenged to be respectful to each and every member of our school community regardless of how they may treat us or our children. The beauty of attending Catholic Schools is we are not exclusive, which means we do enrol children from many different faiths, we enrol children from many different walks of life. Each child that attends our school will most likely have differing expectations at home. At our school though each child and adult is required to support the ethos and mission of our Catholic school.

Just as we know some children learn to read or write or walk or jump at different rates so do some children learn to respond to behavioural norms at different rates. We know that when it comes to spelling some children will take much longer to learn how to spell words. Equally some children need more support and encouragement when learning the appropriate way to behave. Research also tells us that children learn best when they are explicitly taught and encouraged how to cohabit and behave within a community.

As adults it will always be our role to support, encourage, explicitly teach and respect that children need encouragement when learning. When adults respond as poor role models by speaking negatively about other children or adults we are showing children that it's ok to be disrespectful about others. We always encourage our children of Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School to use their respectful words when addressing a concern.

Presentation Sisters established our school 145 years ago. In 2075 our school will be 200 years old. What will be the same is the same core values that were established in 1875, respect for ourselves, others and learning.

The challenge we all have as the current custodians of this school is to enhance the qualities of others by living our lives as Jesus demonstrated. We are required to leave a legacy that serves others through actions. Look around our school this week and challenge yourself to be Christ like in the way you deal and think of others, our children are watching us so they too can reflect the face of Christ.

Compass

Next week, letters and emails will be sent containing login details for Compass. Compass is our new Parent's Portal.

What does Compass do for me?

Using Compass allows you to access up-to-date and meaningful information about our school and your child's progress. Compass includes many different features, including the ability to:

- Monitor your child's attendance, and enter an explanation for absence or lateness
- Communicate with your child's teachers, and update your family contact details
- View your child's timetable and the school calendar
- Monitor your child's homework and assessment tasks
- Download and view your child's progress and semester reports
- Book parent-teacher conferences
- Pay and provide consent for events and school fees

Our school will advise parents when each of these features becomes available for parent use.

Accessing Compass

Compass is a web-based system that is accessible on any modern web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari) or by using the Compass iOS or Android apps. Search for 'Compass School Manager' in the store.

Every family receives a separate login to Compass which will be provided to you by our school. To access the parent portal, go to our school website and click the Compass link on the homepage.

If you already created an account, you can just log in and order for this date. You will need to update your child's class for 2020 if you haven't already.




Subs for You, Account Set-Up


