Uniform Update

Thanks to the 202 people who completed the recent survey on our Sports Uniform. We asked two questions.

- Would you prefer to keep the existing school rugby jumper for our school sports uniform?
- Would you prefer the alternative Fleece Lined ¼ Zip Jumper suggestion?

66% of people indicated they would prefer to keep the Rugby jumper, 34% voted against the Rugby jumper
48% indicated they would prefer the Fleece Lined Jumper, 52% voted against the Fleece Lined jumper.

The Sacred Heart Catholic School Board met last week and discussed the results of the survey. We agreed that there would be no change to our uniform for 2022 aside from the changes we have already made for 2022 (listed below).

The SHS Board will investigate a few changes to the current Rugby Jumper. We will keep families informed of these.

Families are reminded that the following information was shared earlier this year

The Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School Board after input from the Uniform Team and input from parent and staff survey data have finalised a change to our school uniform for 2022.

Commencing 2022 Prep children will wear Sports Uniform 5 days a week.

- 2022 Kinder and Prep will wear Sports Uniform full time
- 2023 Kinder to Grade 1 Sports Uniform
- 2024 Kinder to Grade 2 Sports Uniform

Lemon socks/stockings

Parents are reminded girls may wear either lemon socks or stockings.

Short or long sleeve shirts

SHS Board has finalised a change to our Uniform Policy. Boys and girls may choose to wear short or long sleeve shirts all year round. Please remember this includes a tie for boys (we understand some families have these on back order)

COVID Update

Sacred Heart is still required to respond to a COVID plan in 2021. Our school community has been outstanding in supporting the expectations we have put in place and we thank you for your past and continued support in keeping our community safe. The following will continue to apply at SHS.

- Parents, visitors, staff and students with cold or flu symptoms are not to come to school. We will contact families to arrange for children to be collected if they present with any of these symptoms.
- Visitors and parents attending school should leave within 10 minutes unless for an organised meeting.
- Adults are required to maintain physical distancing.
- The recording of contact details of visitors to school events held in school venues.
- The recording of contact details of visitors to meetings with staff. (Preferred via the COVID app)
- The provision of hand sanitiser.
- Appropriate COVID safety signage at school entry points.
- Cleaning of frequently touched internal surfaces.

Thank you to our families who are supporting our school and all of our community's health by keeping children home when they are sick. We ask that children are not sent to school if they have coughs, colds and flu like symptoms. Under the COVID - 19 restrictions our school will continue to send home children if they are reflecting these symptoms.

We understand this may be an inconvenience to families, however, we appreciate that you support our entire community.

As we progress towards a new normal, Sacred Heart as guided by Catholic Education Tasmania will continue to take into account the level of risk of COVID-19 which exists in the community together with changes in government restrictions and will calibrate our management of the COVID-19 risk accordingly.

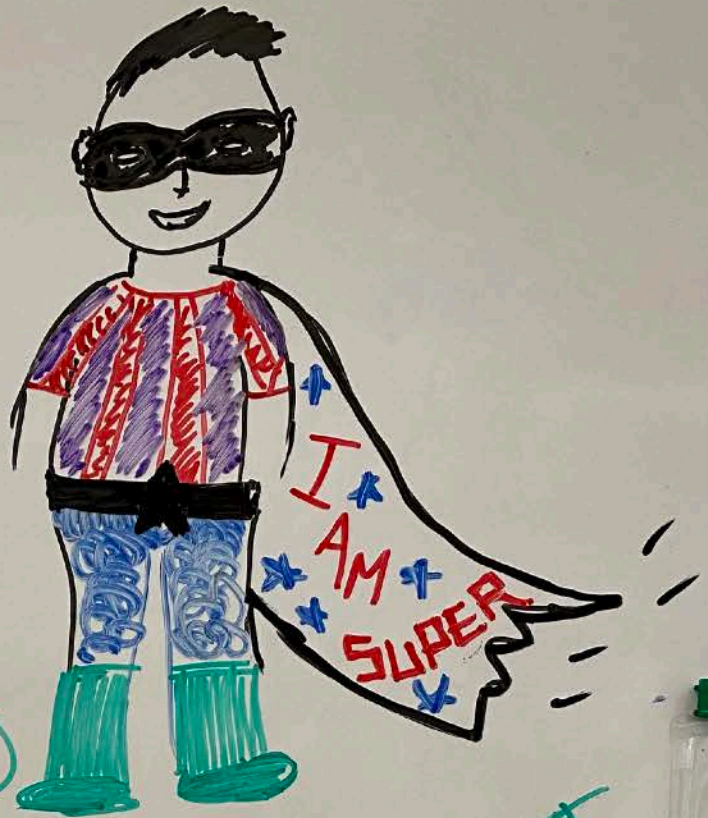

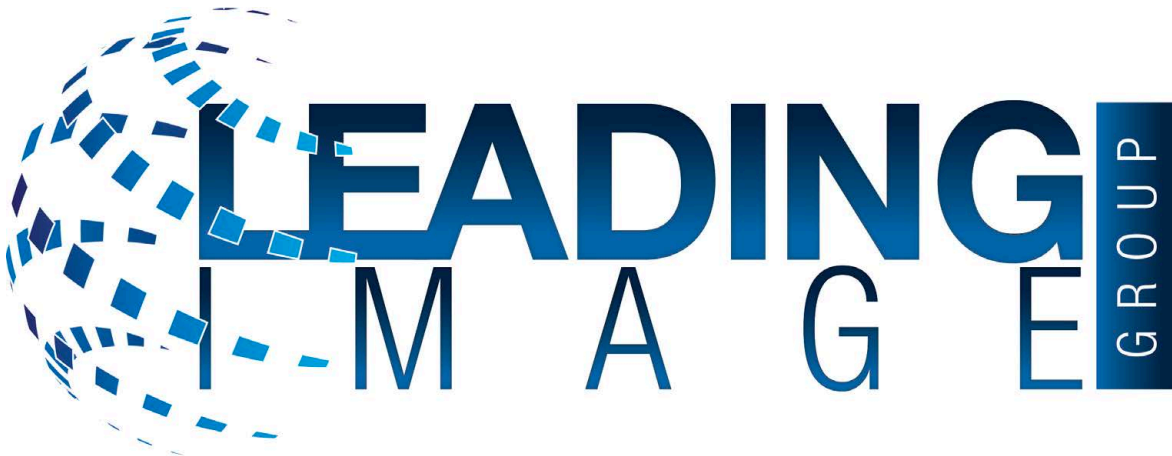

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded

Please note that whilst the government has advised sick children and staff should stay away from schools, we unfortunately see sick children coming in just for a 'quick' photo. We need to stay vigilant in these times uncertain times.
