"Sacred Heart Avenue Grant approval"....

Earlier this year we applied to the Tasmanian Catholic Education Office for a grant to complete SHS Avenue. We sought funding to rectify the paths, walkways, handrails and egresses outside of the Grade 3/4 and Grade 5 block. We are pleased to advise that the grant has been approved by the TCEO. Our Playground Team has also been working on establishing plans for redeveloping the playground outside the Music Room. We are hopeful of working on these projects simultaneously.

The project is being funded by the TCEO Capital Debt Servicing Fund. This fund draws its funds from the contributions that our families, and all Tasmanian Catholic School families, contribute to each year in the Capital Levy. Sacred Heart will also be contributing financially to the completion of the project.

The Playground Project will be funded separately.

UPDATE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As part of our ongoing commitment to providing the best possible educational experience, we have continued to monitor and revise the Terms and Conditions which apply in all Catholic Education Commission Tasmania schools. We will therefore be introducing a small number of updates to the Terms and Conditions, which will apply to all current enrolments continued in 2021 as well as to new enrolments from 2022.

A full copy of the Terms and Conditions is linked below, which you should read carefully. Some changes made to the Terms and Conditions to note are as follows:

- The inclusion of a definition of Humanitarian Entrant;
- Reference to "Healthcare Card" has been changed "Concession Card" to reflect the Fee Assistance Policy;
- The inclusion of an additional paragraph addressing disclosure of information to Seesaw and Services Australia; and
- New questions to capture information regarding Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status of parents/guardians.

By continuing your child's enrolment in 2022 from Monday 17 January 2022, you will be taken to have accepted these updates to the Terms and Conditions.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded




COVID-19 testing for all Tasmanian residents

Do you have any cold or flu-like symptoms?


This includes fever, runny nose, cough, sore/itchy throat or shortness of breath.
