COVID Plan for SHS

Last week we reminded parents of the following information.

Sacred Heart is still required to respond to a COVID plan in 2022. Our school community has been outstanding in supporting the expectations we have put in place and we thank you for your past and continued support in keeping our community safe. The following will continue to apply at SHS.

- Parents, visitors, staff and students with cold or flu symptoms are not to come to school
- Discouraging visitors and parents attending school unless for an organised meeting.
- Adults wearing masks when inside school buildings
- Adults are required to maintain physical distancing.
- The recording of contact details of visitors to school events held in school venues.
- The recording of contact details of visitors to meetings with staff.
- The provision of hand sanitiser.
- Appropriate COVID safety signage at school entry points.
- Cleaning of frequently touched internal surfaces.

- Parents are welcome to enter school grounds. Parents will **not** be able to enter classrooms.
- Kinder will be met by teachers in their playground
- Grades P/1/2 children are asked to put their school bags in totes outside classrooms
- Grades 3- 6 children are asked to leave bags outside classrooms

Pick Up

- Parents are welcome to collect children if necessary. Remember don't enter classrooms.
- Please don't play on equipment before or after school
- Maintain social distancing inside and outside our school grounds

In Week 4 Wednesday 23rd and Thursday 24th February parents and children will meet with teachers to listen to the goals of children for 2022. We have allowed 3.15pm - 7.15pm on both of these days. These conversations will be held via ZOOM.

We have many ways of communicating to parents. Teachers will respond to your questions but are teaching during the day. Please use emails when communicating with staff. Our staff have been asked to respond within 24 hours during the working week. This means that if you have an urgent matter please phone the office.

Assembly

We alternate our assemblies at SHS. On odd weeks (Week 1, 3 etc..) we conduct whole school assemblies. In even weeks (Week 2, 4 etc..) we arrange assemblies Prep - Grade 2 and Grade 3-6.

In 2022 parents will not be able to attend assemblies for the first 5 weeks of Term 1. We will review this and advise parents if there are any changes.

Sacred Heart has cancelled the Welcome BBQ. We were advised to not conduct events which attract large numbers of participants. We will continue to look at other ways we can build our community.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

How to apply for a WWVP and Number

1. Complete the online application form www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.
