## Sacred Heart - Celebrating 150 Years

The Sisters of Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Presentation Sisters) arrived in Tasmania in 1866. In 1873, they came to Launceston to set up a school.

The foundation stone of the building, which is now known as Presentation House and is used by the parish, was laid on the 16th July, 1872 and the Convent was opened on 4th February, 1873. Sacred Heart School commenced on 7th February of the same year.

This year our school celebrates our 150th year. As the oldest Catholic school in Northern Tasmania we are proud of our history and genuinely look forward to the future. Last year our 150 Year Team began planning for 2023. Some of the ways we have immersed the children of Sacred Heart include

- Sharing historical photos of our school, students and staff
- Spent time in classes discovering more about Sacred Heart
- Developed liturgies that focussed on our school

Later this year we will be celebrating in two special ways

- Friday June 16th - Feast Day Celebration. This includes the children of SHS playing 'olden day' games. Archbishop Porteous celebrating mass and SHS gathering to enjoy Sacred Heart's Got Talent

On this day we would like the children of Sacred Heart to dress in 'olden day' clothes. Start looking in your dress up box, maybe ask family and friends or visit an op shop for suitable attire.

- Sunday 18th June 10.30am - Parish Mass. We would love as many families as possible to join us for the parish mass, light morning tea and tours afterwards. We are hopeful Grade 6 children will lead tours and act as hosts on this day.

We have plans for more focus points on our 150th as the year progresses. The parish mass will be an open invitation where we will be seeking RSVP's to understand catering needs. Details sent out shortly.

## Kindergarten 2024

We have commenced our interviews for our 2024 Kindergarten class. Children born in 2019 are eligible to attend Sacred Heart Kinder in 2024. Families are reminded that all children who would like to be considered for enrolment in 2024 must have completed an application form and returned to the Office by May 26th. **WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE REGISTRATION**

If parents do not have registration or registration is pending you will not be able to volunteer and attend the excursion or school event. This is something that we do not want to have to do but as legislation and system policy we need to adhere to.

**How to apply for a WWVP and Number**

1. Complete the online application form [www.justice.tas.gov.au/working\\_with\\_children](http://www.justice.tas.gov.au/working_with_children)
2. Print the "Application Receipt" which is generated when the application has been completed in full
3. Take the "Application Receipt" to a Service Tasmania shop, pay the fee (\$17.60) and have your 100 point check to confirm identity

**Once your registration has been approved and you receive your WWVP card, please bring it to the school office so your name, registration number and expiry date can be recorded and verified.**
